SIGNATURES MANDATORY

for Rider, Owner and Trainer even if the same individual - SIGN all three places!

Reminder: Trainer is the ADULT on the grounds who is responsible for the care of the horse. Trainer is NOT necessarily a riding instructor. The only person who should sign this space is the person who is actually responsible for the care (feed, health) of the horse.

There must be a signature on the Trainer line in order for the bridle number to be given out.

Coach signature required when the coach is on the grounds. Coach must be a member of USEF or pay the non-member fee.

When the care and ownership of the horse is in the hands of a Junior, that Junior's PARENT may sign the Owner line on behalf of the Junior, and may sign the Trainer line if there is no Trainer. Non-member fees will not be charged.

RELEASES MANDATORY

Please note that there are **2** releases that must be signed. The USEF Release has spaces for three signatures. The MEC Release has space for one signature - that of the RIDER.

STABLING REMINDER

If you are planning to stable with a group, please try to identify the group with one name AND have one person in the group send a complete list of horses/riders.

Feed/Bedding order form will be posted on www.goldenstatedressage.com after March 15.

ENTER QUALIFYING CORRECTLY:

First, you do NOT need to indicate "Q" on classes that are eligible to be counted for CDS Qualifying. The "Q" is necessary only for GreatAmericanInsurance/USDF Regional Finals qualifying.

It is also your responsibility to enter the class correctly: Add the "Q" to the class number. Then check the day sheets and the FINAL SCORE SHEETS to be certain that the score is listed as a Qualifying score.

After the show, it is then prudent to do a score-check on www.usdf.org. If they have posted the scores for the show in question and the score is not reflected as Qualifying, please contact USDF and the Show to find out what the problem might be.

* Horses entered in USEF licensed/USDF recognized competitions must have either a USDF LHR or a USDF HID. Exception: Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBC) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at regular competitions (i.e. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, Pas de Deux, Quadrille, or IPEC classes, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy classes and foreign-owned horses competing in a CDI.

** For each USDF non-member owner/lessee and USDF non-member rider there will be a USDF non-member fee of \$20 per competition and a USDF non-member form that must be collected by the show secretary, and submitted to USDF along with the USDF Report of Fees Form. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the non-member number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF non-member fee. If all the owners of the horse are non-members, only one of the owners must pay the non-member fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF member there is no non-member fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF non-member fees not received with the USDF post competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF non-members. Competition management is then required to submit the non-member fees within 30 days to the USDF.

ENTRY AGREEMENT - ALL PROVISIONS APPLY

Owner/agent/participant agrees that show management is merely providing stabling for the convenience of the participant and that management, the sponsoring organizations and the facility shall have no responsibility whatsoever for any injury, loss, damage, etc., as a result of using said stabling. Owner/agent/participant agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold all sponsoring and recognizing organizations, show management, their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers harmless from any loss, damage or claims as a result of said use. Owner/agent/participant assumes all care, custody, and control with regard to this use. Owner/agent/participant agrees that every horse entered or which they bring to the show grounds will be subject to the rules of the horse show management but that neither the horse show management nor any sponsoring organization will, in any case, be responsible for damages as a result of any loss, damage or claim that may occur. They agree to defend, indemnify and hold the horse show facility, horse show management, their directors, officers, officials and/or volunteers and affiliated organizations harmless therefrom.

I hereby agree to release, indemnify and hold harmless **USDF**, its instructors, officers, directors, agents, and volunteers from and against any and all loss, liability or damage arising from or because of, or in connection with, participation in this competition or related activities. I also hereby agree to release, indemnify and hold harmless the show management, show committee and members, officers, directors, agents, and volunteers from and against any and all loss, liability or damage arising from or because of, or in connection with, participation in this competition or related activities.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

FEDERATION RELEASE, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER AND INDEMNIFICATION -

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition to the following:

I AGREE that "the Federation" and "Competition" as used herein includes the Licensee and Competition Management, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and Federation affiliates.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaultor, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death. ("Harm").

I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition.

I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including GR801 and, where applicable, EV114, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf.

I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition.

I AGREE that if I am injured at this competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the Federation on the official USEF accident/injury report form.
